

## TBIT Employee Security Screening

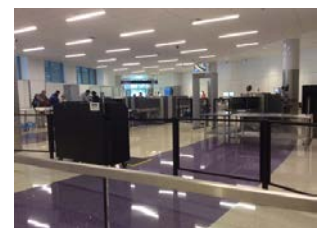
Airport Operations, TSA, and TBIT stakeholders are making a concerted effort to mitigate congestion at TSA's primary security check point at TBIT. To aid this effort, a community endeavor is currently underway to redirect employee screening to the T4 Connector check-point.

Effective Monday, August 8<sup>th</sup>, 2016, TSA will operate the "employee check point lanes" at the T4 connector from 0600 to 2200. This check point can be accessed from TBIT Arrivals, through the doors south of the interline recheck area.

While this check point continues to serve the interline passengers transitioning to other Terminals for connecting flights, TBIT Airlines are encouraged to use this T4 connector check point for screening flight crews as well.

TSA will fully support the check-point operation to ensure ease of screening for employees. TSA will also accommodate employees at the main check point when the lower level T4 Connector check point is closed.
