1. Terminal 2: Pedestrian Bridge Demolition


- To facilitate future construction for the Automated People Mover (APM) project, the Pedestrian Bridge connecting Terminal 2 and Parking Structure 2A will be demolished later this month
- Soft demolition activity is scheduled to begin this week, with structural demolition and removal of the bridge scheduled for late January 2021
- The Pedestrian Bridge will close to the public prior to the start of demolition activity; temporary signage will be in place





2. Overnight Ramp Closures: APM Construction

- Overnight closures of the northbound or southbound ramps at the entrance / exit to LAX (Century Boulevard and Sepulveda Boulevard) are needed through January 22, 2021 to facilitate construction of the Automated People Mover guideway over Sepulveda Boulevard
- Only one ramp will be closed at a time; detours and temporary signage will be in place




Eastbound Century Blvd to Northbound Sepulveda Blvd Ramp Closure

3. Terminal 2 / 3 Construction Update: Exterior Façade

- The Departures Level right drop-off lane is closed through mid-November 2021 while it is used as a temporary pedestrian walkway to maintain passenger traffic during construction
- Pictured below, the exterior façade of the future Head House building continues to be installed, helping the building look more and more like its final state
