



1. Overnight Ramp Closures: APM Construction

- Overnight closures of the northbound and / or southbound ramps at the entrance / exit to LAX (Century Boulevard and Sepulveda Boulevard) are needed through May 15, 2021 to facilitate construction of the Automated People Mover guideway over Sepulveda Boulevard
- Detours and temporary signage will be in place




Eastbound Century Blvd to Northbound Sepulveda Blvd Ramp Closure

2. Terminal 3 Pedestrian Walkway


- Work to construct a temporary, covered pedestrian walkway on the Departures Level at Terminal 3 is now complete; the walkway is scheduled to be in place through October 2022
- During construction of the walkway, pedestrians were routed on the outermost drop-off lane in front of Terminal 3 and both drop-off lanes were closed
- Now that the temporary walkway is complete, guests will be routed on the innermost drop-off lane with the outermost drop-off lane re-opened for traffic



3. EXTENDED Terminal 5.5: Arrivals Level Inner Lane Closure

- All Arrivals Level Inner Lanes between Terminals 5 and 6 are closed 24/7 through June 2021 (extended from March 2021) to facilitate underground utility work for the Terminal Cores and APM Interface Project
- Detours and wayfinding signage are in place to maintain vehicular and pedestrian traffic
- Signage is posted directing guests to the next available shuttle stops where existing stops are closed or relocated
