1. Automated People Mover: Guideway Construction

- Construction of the APM guideway over Sepulveda Boulevard is scheduled to begin Wednesday, January 12 and run through the end of the month
- During nightly construction, up to two lanes on Sepulveda Boulevard near LAX will be restricted with at least one lane in both directions maintained
- Construction of the guideway will be performed using Segmental Construction techniques, working from either side of Sepulveda Boulevard to connect the guideway in the middle; this was the same technique used to construct the guideway over Century Boulevard while maintaining traffic




Aerial view of the APM guideway to be connected over Sepulveda Boulevard



2. Terminal 3: Pedestrian Bridge

- Construction of a Pedestrian Bridge connecting Terminal 3 to the APM's West Station begins
 this week with nightly lane restrictions and / or full closures scheduled through February 19,
 2022 to facilitate construction
- This week, full closures of Arrivals Level Outer Lanes at Terminal 3 are scheduled overnight Wednesday, January 12 through Friday, January 14 to install a shoring tower, and again Saturday, January 15 through Tuesday, January 25 to install the Pedestrian Bridge
- Detour and temporary wayfinding signage, along with flaggers, will be utilized to maintain traffic and pedestrian flow during construction



When Arrivals Level Outer Lanes are fully closed, vehicles are detoured to Inner Lanes or West Way

3. Super Bowl & Construction Moratoriums

- The 2022 Super Bowl will be held in Los Angeles on Sunday, February 13
- To accommodate the anticipated increase in passenger and vehicular traffic, a Construction Moratorium will be in effect Thursday, February 10 at 6AM through Tuesday, February 15 at 6AM, limiting types of impactful construction activity that can be performed during this time
