

1. Terminal 1: Nightly Shuttle Stop Impacts Complete This Week

- As a reminder, the Rental Car Shuttle Stop (purple) at Terminal 1 is being relocated to the east to collocate with the existing Shared Ride Van & Charter Bus Shuttle Stop (orange) through this week on Wednesday, November 9
- The relocation and related impacts are during limited overnight hours from 1AM to 6AM
- The crosswalk to the closed Rental Car Shuttle Stop is barricaded when the existing stop is closed
- Signage will be in place nightly to direct guests to the relocated stop



The existing Rental Car stop will be relocated nightly to collocate with the Shared Ride Van & Charter Bus stop at Terminal 1 through Wednesday, November 9 (1AM to 6AM only)



2. Terminal 4 / 5: Terminal Vertical Core Building Now Open

- The Terminal Vertical Core between Terminals 4 and 5 is now open!
- The building provides vertical circulation (escalators and elevators), new check-in and baggage claim areas, consolidated TSA screening, and pre- and post-security connection between the two terminals
- Once the Automated People Mover project is complete, the Terminal 4/5 Vertical Core will provide access to the APM's West CTA Station via a pedestrian bridge over the roadways
- Construction in both terminals will continue as part of American Airlines' Terminal 4/5
 Modernization Program, which is scheduled to complete in 2027; the next phase of which is
 schedule to complete in 2024 and includes a new portion of the Terminal 4 Headhouse for
 ticketing and bag claim, and a new portion of the south concourse for hold rooms, gates,
 concessions, restrooms and more

3. Terminal B: Removal of APM Tower Crane

- Work to remove the second of two tower cranes at the site of the APM West CTA Station is scheduled to complete this week on Wednesday, November 9
- Nightly impacts are anticipated on Arrivals Level roadways as crews disassemble and remove the crane; traffic will be maintained at all times
- Always use caution when traveling near construction areas
